Winchester Morris Men was formed on the 11th March 1953 in the Eclipse Inn, Winchester. Our costume and dance style is reconstructed from that of the Cotswold region circa 1890, as collected by Cecil Sharp and others in Bampton, Bledington, Fieldtown and Ilmington. Most of the dances we perform are in sets of six men. Occasionally a jig danced by one or two men may be included in the programme. We dance for our own and our audiences' pleasure in Winchester and the surrounding villages, with occasional weekends away as guests of other sides.
